

Occupational Health and Safety Policy

Goanna Plumbing recognises its duty of care to ensure the health and safety of its workers, and those workers who are influenced by the actions of Goanna Plumbing.

Goanna Plumbing will ensure that the health and safety of other persons is not put at risk by work undertaken by Goanna Plumbing.

Goanna Plumbing Management will ensure its duty of care by:

- Providing and maintaining a safe work environment
- Providing and maintaining safe plant and structures
- Providing and maintaining safe systems of work
- Ensuring the safe use, handling and storage of plant, structures and substances
- Providing adequate facilities for ensuring the welfare of its workers
- Providing adequate training, information, instruction and supervision
- Monitoring the health and wellbeing of its workers for the purpose of preventing injury and illness

Furthermore, management will ensure that entering, exiting and anything that arises from processes within the Goanna Plumbing workplace, including but not limited to its fixtures, fittings and plant, will not cause risk to health and safety.

Goanna Plumbing Workers, while at work must:

- Take reasonable care of their own health and safety care
- Ensure their acts or omissions do not jeopardise the health and safety of others
- Follow instruction, training and work processes so far as is reasonably practicable to ensure the health and safety of all
